Courses

29.06. The Tallinn Championship is held on the shortened long distance, except categories MN21A – middle distance. The exact lengths of the courses will be detailed later.

30.06. Competition will be held on long distance. The approximate lengths of the circuits will be as follows:

Competition rules

The helmet is mandatory - competitors without helmet are not allowed in the start.

Leaving the bike for visiting the CP is not allowed; if doing so, the competitor will be disqualified. Applied is the rule to meet the bikers coming from the opposite direction of the track by the right. While driving on the roads traffic rules must be observed. Particular PRECAUTION is needed when crossing the roads! The competitor is participating the competition at his own risk and the fact of his or her registration on the competitors list is considered as the guarantee of the competitors own responsibility. The shortcuts between the tracks in the forest are allowed.

Start set-up

Prestart time is 2 min. The orienteering map is handed over 1 min before the starting time.

Marking system

SPORTIdent AIR punching system applicable for all the categories. While registering, the competitor has to report his or her SI-chip number.

The rent of SI-chips is possible with the additional cost of $1,5 \in$.

The capture range of installed SI-stations for marking is 0.3 meters.

The SI punching range of the finish station is 1,8 m.

Awarding

Tallinn's Championship: Three of the best times in all categories will be awarded with Tallinn's medals (regardless of the number of participants in that category). All winners of the main categories will be awarded with the Tallinn's souvenir.

Tallinn's Championship is supported by the Tallinn's municipality.

In the summary of two days in Park Tour of MTBO Tallinn 2019, the overall score is obtained by summing the points. The points according the

placement on the both stages will be given to the first 40 best times as follows: I place - 50 points, II - 45 points, III - 41 points, IV - 38 points, V - 36, VI - 35, ..., 40. place - 1 point. In case of equity in points, the sum of times of the two competition days will be considered. Will be awarded the three bests of each category. In case of less than 10 participants in a category, only the first place will be awarded.

Registration

The registration is open until 25.06 at 23:59 on the web site https://www.osport.ee/. While registering, the participation fee has to be transferred on the banking account of the orienteering club Nõmme; A/A EE507700771001309152 (LHV). The additional registering is possible in the limit of the complementary places against the fee of registration multiplied by 1.5. While registering, required is also the information about the need to rent the SI-chip.
